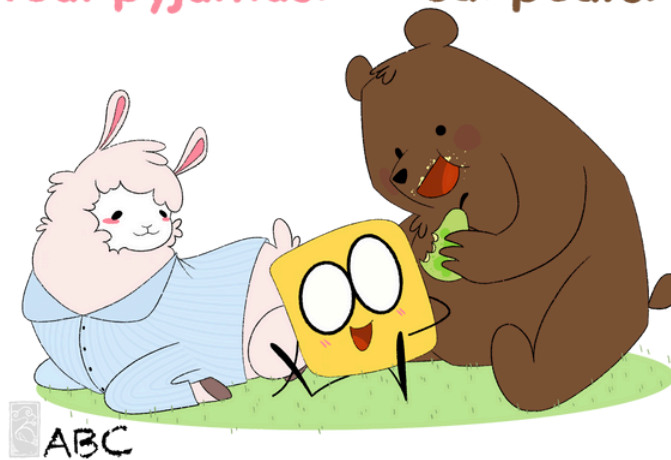


Rhyming

Rhymes occur when the last syllable(s) of two or more words share the same sound. In English, rhyming words usually have different beginning sounds but the same vowel and ending sounds.

fridge, bridge, ridge

happy, snappy, sappy

extinguish, distinguish, relinquish

Rhyming words with different vowels :

said, read, bed

bird, curd, heard

four, roar, bore

hawk, rock, chalk

height, right, kite
