


## Rhyming

Rhymes occur when the last syllable(s) of two or more words share the same sound. In English, rhyming words usually have different beginning sounds but the same vowel and ending sounds.



## Rhyming words with common vowels:

call, ball, all

mole, bowl, roll

fridge, bridge, ridge

happy, snappy, sappy

extinguish, distinguish, relinguish

fridge, bridge, ridge,

## Rhyming words with different vowels:

said, read, bed

bird, curd, heard


four, roar, bore

height, right, kite
