

**Beginner:** Search for individual letters of the alphabet in your environment. **[Tip]:** Business signs, license plates, cereal boxes, shampoo bottles.

Intermediate: Search for sight words in your environment. [Tip]: Words like "and" and "the" are commonly used sight words.

**Experienced:** Search your environment for the letters in the order needed to spell a word.

**[Tip]:** You can spell "FROM" with the letter "F" from a license plate, "R" from a billboard, "O" from a stop sign, "M" from a restaurant name. Keep letters in your head or write them down as you go.

What is Environmental Print? Environmental print are words that appear on labels, logos, and signs. They can be thought of as "the print of everyday life".

Why is this important? This activity will support children in learning word recognition, which can be used in a fun way to practice letter knowledge.

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**English Sight Words** are commonly used in beginner books, because **repetition** is helpful when learning to read. Learning to recognize these sight words automatically can help develop better fluency (flow) when reading.
