



**Climate Title:** Can You Find the Way?

**Description:** Which way should I go from here?

**Goal:** Stand outside and learn the direction of places like home and school, where the sun rises and sets, and where the moon is located during the day. Talk about the four cardinal points: North, South, East and West.

**[Tip]** “The sun rises in the east and sets in the west” “Where is the moon right now?” “Does the street run East to West, or North to South?” What stars are visible in the northern sky?

**Why?** Learning about directions helps you to explore your place in the world.
