Beginner: Draw and talk about how beans, corn and squash are the same and different.

[Tip]: SAME: all vegetables, food, thrive together; DIFFERENT: shapes, sizes

Intermediate: Talk about the environments where plants grow.

[Tip]: Manitoba has grasslands (corn, rice, wheat), boreal forest (berries, mushrooms, herbs) and tundra (roots, leaves, flowers).

Experienced: Talk about ways to cook the harvest together.

[Tip]: Write a recipe that includes beans, corn and squash.

[Brief] Why? Exposure to different cultural stories and ways of knowing improves background knowledge, vocabulary and listening skills.
