



Magnetic Alphabet Game

Let's Play With Letters!

Beginner: Arrange magnetic letters on a table, fridge or cookie sheet. Help your child name different letters.

[Tip]: Start by naming the letters in your child's name.

Intermediate: Arrange magnetic letters on a table, fridge or cookie sheet. Help your child name the letters and put the alphabet in order.

[Tip]: Sing the alphabet song with your child to help put the letters in order.

Experienced: Arrange magnetic letters on a table, fridge or cookie sheet. Have your child identify letter names and the sounds they make.

[Tip]: Ask your child to name a place, person, animal, or thing that starts with a certain letter/sound.

Why is this important? Letter recognition is important because it helps children understand how printed text is connected with the spoken language.
