



License Plate Literacy

Learn the Letters!

Beginner: Point out different license plates with your child such as local plates, custom plates, or license plates from other areas.

[Tip]: Look for license plates on vehicles while driving or going for a walk.

Intermediate: Have your child say the letters on different license plates.

[Tip]: "This license plate has a B!" Identify the letters versus the numbers.

Experienced: Have your child say a word for each letter in a license plate.

[Tip]: If the license plate reads GJG, they could say "Go, Jets, Go!"

Why is this important? A first step to reading is learning letter names and sounds.
