



Identify that Vehicle!

What Do you See?

Beginner: Identify the colours of nearby vehicles.

[Tip]: “What colour is the car passing by? What colour is the car to the left of us?”

Intermediate: Identify the types of nearby vehicles.

[Tip]: Ask “What type of vehicle is that?” (ex. car, truck, bus, van, etc.)

Experienced: Identify the purposes of nearby vehicles.

[Tip]: “The school bus brings kids to and from school”

Why is this important? Learning how to identify different attributes of objects helps children develop vocabulary and early reading skills.
